Harris has served as AHCA's Assistant Deputy Secretary for Medicaid Policy & Quality since February 2017. In this role, she is responsible for overseeing the bureaus of Medicaid Policy and Medicaid Quality, which includes over 110 employees. Harris has been responsible for directing the development of comprehensive Medicaid strategic and program plans to efficiently and effectively carry out the Agency goals and objectives, including serving as the lead to implement the administration's Canadian Prescription Drug Importation Program. Harris has served at AHCA for over a decade and has previously held the positions of Bureau Chief, Medicaid Policy and AHCA Administrator. In addition to her work at AHCA, she has served as an Adjunct Professor at Florida State University and a Case Manager at Big Bend Cares serving vulnerable Floridians.

Harris holds a Master of Business Administration from Quinnipiac University, a Master of Social Work from Florida State University and received her Bachelor of Science in Psychology and Minor in Business for Florida State University.
