Re: Update: Congressional Redistricting Subcommittee Meeting

Following the Florida Supreme Court's opinion today, the House has resumed its congressional redistricting process. This afternoon, a Congressional Redistricting Subcommittee meeting was noticed for Monday, February 14, however it was my desire for Members to have more time to review the proposed map. I reached out to Chair Leek to see what options were available for adjusting the schedule. He has graciously given up the Redistricting Committee's timeslot for next Friday, which now allows the subcommittee to meet at that time. This change will allow Members more time to review the proposed congressional districts (H000C8011) that were published this evening as PCB CRS 22-01, along with the associated materials.

The proposed congressional districts (<u>H000C8011</u>) and the associated archive records can be found <u>here</u>. These same archive records can also be accessed from any user's Esri map drawing application profile. A snapshot of statistics can be found <u>here</u>.
