SENATOR TADDEO JOINS DEMOCRATIC COLLEAGUES IN CALL TO EXPAND THE SPECIAL SESSION TO INCLUDE RENTAL RELIEF

Miami — Governor DeSantis' outright refusal to address the massive housing crisis has forced millions of Floridians to pay excessive rent and home insurance rate hikes. Not only has the Governor intentionally neglected this crisis and only called a Special Session after many calls to do so, but the Governor signed into law last year a bill that raised Citizens Insurance Premiums even more which in turn is reflected in an increase of rent for millions.

Since these two grave issues go hand in hand it is only right that our Governor expand the upcoming special session to address the current rental crisis faced across Florida.
