To Whom It May Concern:

Well, as I have predicted, not being listed is no surprise. The Public Service Commission Nominating Council and Senate and House leadership got their marching orders from Associated Industries of Florida, and have acted accordingly.

I take some pride in having leveled the playing field, consistent with the law, so that the ratepayer, with no protection other than the integrity of five Commissioners, could compete with the monopolies, protected by the 4th Amendment. That this should have cost me my job, given the decrepitude of the legislature, was a foregone conclusion.

There is no counterbalance to special interest influence upon the legislature, no citizen/ratepayer group, certainly not the elected representatives, and restrictions on the AARP insure that even the inherent decency and fair-mindedness of that group is unavailing. Money talks in Tallahassee, and it speaks more loudly each campaign session. It has spoken loudly in this matter.

I have prepared and will be submitting a column to the major media outlets, so that the people can have some sense of what is occurring in the halls of their government.

I have advised that the influence of a corrupted and corruptible legislature is at the heart of Public Service Commission dysfunction. This message, obviously, has not been well received.
